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Divya Chhabra

Divya Chhabra was born in Pune, India on May 17 in 1967. She has been practicing classical homoeopathy in Mumbai, India, for the past ten years. Dr. Chhabra graduated from Smt. Chandaben Mohanbhai Patel Homoeopathic Medical College, Mumbai, in 1989, and began her practice in 1992. Dr. Chhabra has been teaching in India and abroad for the last seven years and has lectured in various parts of the world such as Switzerland, Germany, Austria, England, Ireland, Belgium, Holland, Greece, the Slovakia Republic, Australia, New Zealand, the U.S. and Canada. She has conducted provings of several remedies including Magnesia sulphurica, Thea, Citrus, Lac Felinum, Lac Rhesus, Tungsten, Lac Defloratum, Lac Humanum, Eagle, and Bat. She has also conducted a potency proving with two well-proven polycrest remedies, Calcarea carbonicum and Natrum muriaticum, in potencies from 30 to 50 M. Her work has helped further our understanding of more accurately selecting potencies. Dr. Chhabra is well known for her brilliant style of case taking in which she follows the thread of every important symptom beautifully to reach the core feeling state of the individual. She has been artfully employing a technique called "free association" in her case taking method that enables one to reach through the subconscious level of dreams to the deep seated core delusion which manifests as the symptoms of imbalance and illness. Presently, she is working on three books, including one on her provings, another on her experience in practice including free association, use of potencies, etc., and, most recently, a book on her advances in the understanding of the materia medica of the periodic table of the elements.

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Gabriel Cousens MD(H)

Dr. Gabriel Cousens is one of the world's foremost authorities on living food nutrition, holistic lifestyle and complementary medicine. He is Founder/director of the Tree of Life Rejuvenation Center in Patagonia, Arizona. He received his M.D. degree from Columbia



Medical School in 1969 and completed his psychiatry residency in 1973. He was the Chief Mental Health Consultant for the Sonoma County Operation Head Start and a consultant for the California State Department of Mental Health. Dr. Cousens is a holistic medical doctor, a psychiatrist and family therapist, and a licensed homeopathic physician in the state of Arizona. He uses the modalities of live-food nutrition, naturopathy, Ayurveda, homeopathy and acupuncture, blended with spiritual awareness, in the healing of body, mind and spirit. A best-selling author of Conscious Eating, Depression-Free for Life, Spiritual Nutrition and the Rainbow Diet as well as several other books.

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Gladys McGarey MD

Dr. Gladys McGarey is internationally recognized as the Mother of Holistic Medicine. In practice as a family doctor from 1946 to 2004, she relentlessly advocated and advanced the emergence of holistic patient care. Often, in the early years, she experienced staunch opposition from a male-dominated medical establishment. In 1970, she co-founded the A.R.E. Clinic in Phoenix, Arizona, where she and her former husband pioneered the integration of allopathic and holistic medical practices, laying groundwork for the cDr. McGarey is past president of The American Holistic Medical Association and the Arizona Board of Homeopathic Medical Examiners; and a Founding Diplomat of the American Board of Holistic Medicine. She is on the Advisory Board of Arizona State University East. Among her many awards are the Humanities Award for Outstanding Service to Mankind, from the National Committee for the Advancement of Parapsychology and Medicine (1990); a 1998 YWCA Tribute to Women award in the healer category; and the David Stackhouse Award for pioneering excellence in homeopathy (1994). In May of 2003 she was honored by the American Holistic Medical Association as a Pioneer of Holistic Medicine.



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Massimo Mangliavori, MD

Massimo Mangialavori was born in the city of Naples, Italy on 30 November 1958, growing up first in Milan, and then from 1966 in Modena, where he has lived and worked ever since. Mangialavori qualified as a doctor in 1984, and then specialized in Food Sciences at the University of Modena, under Professor Nino Battistini, gaining his diploma in 1987. His thesis was on the effects of fasting in human beings. He studied medical anthropology from the beginning of his university career, and out of this grew an interest in traditional forms of medicine. This in turn led him to dedicate himself entirely to classical homeopathy, which he has been practicing since 1985. He attended some courses in homeopathy in Italy, as well as various seminars throughout Europe, but remained rather dissatisfied. Only after meeting Dr Giovanni Marotta of Roma, and the years of study and reflection that they spent together, did he continue his work with enthusiasm. He then developed a personal methodology for the study and application of homeopathy. For the past few years, Dr. Mangialavori has been sharing this with various groups of colleagues, both in Italy and abroad. In 1991 he began to teach, thanks to invitations from Dr. Hans Zwemke of Berlin, and from colleagues in the Dutch Homeopathic Society, chiefly Dr Cees Baas and Dr Fernand Debats.

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Jeremy Sherr RSHom, MCH

Jeremy Sherr was born April 2, 1955, in South Africa, and grew up in Israel. Homoeopathy found him 23 years ago, and Jeremy began formal studies at the College of Homoeopathy, London, in 1980. He completed a degree simultaneously in Acupuncture at the International College of Oriental Medicine.



Though he has practiced homoeopathy exclusively since 1982, his knowledge of Chinese Medicine shines through his homoeopathic thinking.

Mr. Sherr began teaching while still in college. He taught in most of the British schools, and began his Dynamis School in 1987. It is the longest running post-graduate course in the UK. Jeremy has taught the Dynamis curriculum throughout Europe and North America, and is a popular lecturer worldwide. He maintains a busy practice in London, Tel Aviv, and New York.

He was the first to re-develop the science and art of provings after a century of near silence. In 1982 he conducted his first proving of Scorpion, and has since completed 21 thorough provings.

He has written *The Dynamics and Methodology of Homoeopathic Provings*, which has become a standard textbook in most colleges and the basis of worldwide proving guidelines. It has been translated into French, German, and Russian.

He was awarded a fellowship from the Society of Homoeopaths in 1991 and a Ph.D. from *Medicina Alternativa*. He is a Member of the North American Society of Homoeopaths, and is an honorary professor of Yunan Medical College, Kunming, China.

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William Tiller PhD

William Tiller, Ph.D.

(www.tiller.org) graduated with a B.A.Sc. in 1952 with a degree in Engineering Physics from the University of Toronto. He also has an M.A.Sc. and a Ph.D. from the University of Toronto. He worked for nine years in the Westinghouse

Research Laboratory with theoretical and experimental investigation into the detailed physics of the freezing process of a wide range of materials; i. e., water, metals, semiconductors, oxides and polymers. He also investigated the relationships between the crystallization process and the detailed structure and properties of the solid. He exploited this knowledge of crystallization to generate new processes for ingot casting, material purification, single crystal growth, chemical crystallizers, etc.

Dr. Tiller has been a professor at Stanford University in the Department of materials science and Engineering. He has been a consultant to government and industry in the fields of metallurgy and solid-state physics and formerly Associate Editor of 2 scientific journals. He has published more than 250 scientific papers, three technical books and has five patents issued. His fields of specialization are crystal growth, surfaces and interfaces, physical metallurgy, semiconductor processing, thin film formation, computer simulation and psychoenergetics (70 additional publications in this area). He is also the founding director of the Academy of Parapsychology and Medicine and The Institute of Noetic Sciences. His Publications include *An Introduction to Computer Simulation: The Science of Crystallization: Microscopic Interfacial Phenomena*, *The Science of Crystallization: Macroscopic Phenomena and Defect Generation*, *Science and Human Transformation*, *Conscious Acts of Creation and Some Science Adventures with Real Magic* (available April/May 2005).

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Andrew Weil MD

Andrew Weil, M.D., is a world-renowned leader and pioneer in the field of integrative medicine, a healing oriented approach to health care which encompasses body, mind, and spirit. Combining a Harvard



education and a lifetime of practicing natural and preventive medicine, Dr. Weil is the founder and director of the Arizona Center for Integrative Medicine (AzCIM) at the University of Arizona Health Sciences Center, in Tucson, where he is also a Clinical Professor of Medicine and Professor of Public Health and the Lovell-Jones Professor of Integrative Rheumatology. Dr. Weil received both his medical degree and his undergraduate AB degree in biology (botany) from Harvard University.

Dr. Weil is an internationally-recognized expert for his views on leading a healthy lifestyle, his philosophy of healthy aging, and his critique of the future of medicine and health care. Approximately 10 million copies of Dr. Weil's books have been sold, including *Spontaneous Healing*, *8 Weeks to Optimum Health*, *Eating Well for Optimum Health*, *The Healthy Kitchen*, *Healthy Aging*, and *Why Our Health Matters*.
