He has conducted 26 Homeopathic Proving Trials, many focusing on local flora and fauna. He also is a homeopathic leader and has served on numerous boards within the homeopathic community including president of the National Center for Homeopathy and president of the Arizona Board of Homeopathic and Integrated Medicine Examiners.

It is the responsibility of each student to know and follow all the written information and requirements provided in this syllabus. The faculty reserves the right to make changes to the syllabus as deemed necessary. In the event of a change the faculty will notify all students in a timely manner both verbally and in writing.

## Attendance Requirements

Students are required to attend a minimum of **90% of all mentorship classes** in this practicum-based course. Unavoidable absences will require make-up work to be arranged with the faculty mentor. Faculty mentors, at their discretion, may work with the students who have excessive absences caused by special circumstances such as illness, injury, family tragedy, etc. In such cases, the faculty mentor and the student must come up with an alternative learning plan for the missed work. This plan may include additional assignments, research, written reports, and/or tutoring. The alternative learning plan/special arrangements must be in writing, signed by the student and faculty, and filed with the academic office. The student may be charged for make-up tutorials.

## Technology

This class operates using Zoom technology for mentorship. The Technology Coordinator will work with each student and instructor to ensure smooth operations of on-line technology for both synchronous and asynchronous learning. Please contact the Technology Coordinator with any technology questions or concerns.

## Grading

Grading is based on total scores from assignments, testing, class participation, and attendance. A passing grade is a "C-" or higher. Students who fail a course are required to retake the course to receive credit toward program completion.

Students who receive an “F” in a co-requisite or prerequisite course will not be permitted to register for the next level course until they have retaken the course and received a passing grade.

**Incomplete Grades**

Incomplete grades are limited to those students who have extenuating circumstances and who have met all the requirements of the course, and who still need to submit a late paper, or make up an exam or missed classes.

If incomplete work is not achieved in the allotted timeframe, which is one semester, the grade will be converted to a grade of “F” and the student will need to repeat the course.

**Students Retaking an Examination**

If a student scores below 70% on an exam, the faculty member may grant a retake of the exam in question. Exam retakes, which are at the discretion of the faculty member, should take place within 2 weeks of the original exam date, or within two weeks of the date the student was informed of his/her exam result.

The following steps establish the criteria for retaking an exam:

- 1) The mentor will contact the student as soon as possible.
- 2) The student then may schedule to retake the exam with a proctor (please check with Registrar for current rates).
- 3) The highest grade that a student may receive on an exam retake is a B+.

**Student Conduct**

It is the responsibility of students to be knowledgeable about the rules and regulations which govern acceptable conduct and activities. General information on student conduct and discipline is contained in the Catalog.

**Use of PIHMA Email Address**

Faculty and students are required to use PIHMA email addresses for all correspondence. If there are any problems with the use of the email, contact the Chief Operations Officer.

**Guest Speakers**

Students are expected to maintain a demeanor that is polite and consistent with professional courtesy to fellow students, and faculty. The faculty member may ask students who exhibit disrespectful, uncivil, or unprofessional behavior to leave the class.

**Academic Honesty**

PIHMA Faculty and staff support student learning by providing high quality instruction and access to learning resources. The primary factor in student success, however, is the student's commitment to the learning process. A successful grade in a PIHMA course indicates mastery of the material achieved through hard work.

Any form of academic dishonesty, whether cheating or plagiarism, undermines the value of grades for the entire student body and the College as a whole. The College does not tolerate any form of academic dishonesty. Any student attempting to gain an unfair advantage in a course will be penalized, up to and including suspension. The actions taken will also be permanently entered into the student's file in the case of repeated incidents.

For purposes of this policy, the following definitions apply:

**Cheating** is defined as dishonesty in an academic assignment. It may involve:



- Copying or attempting to copy from others during an examination or for an assignment;
- Communicating examination information to, or receiving such information from, another person during an examination;
- Using, attempting to use, or assisting others in using materials that are prohibited or inappropriate in the context of the academic assignment or examination in question, such as: books, Web sites, prepared answers, written notes, or concealed information;
- Allowing others to do one's assignment or a portion of one's assignment or using a commercial semester paper service;
- Altering examination answers after an assignment has been completed or altering recorded grades; and
- Resubmitting a previously written assignment for a new course without the permission of the faculty member.

**Plagiarism** is defined as using another's work (whether printed, electronic, or spoken) without crediting him or her. Whereas cheating is almost always intentional, students sometimes plagiarize accidentally. It is vital, therefore, for students to understand the many different kinds of actions that constitute plagiarism:

- Submitting the whole of another's work as one's own (see the definition of "cheating" above: this includes submitting another student's paper or a paper obtained from a commercial semester paper service as one's own);
- Using the exact wording of a source without putting that wording in quotation marks and citing it;
- Paraphrasing the wording of a source without citing it;
- Inadequately paraphrasing the wording of a source (not only the words, but the sentence structure of the original must be changed);
- Summarizing the ideas of a source without citing it; and
- Overusing the ideas of a source, so that those ideas make up the majority of one's work.

In the case of an alleged case of academic dishonesty, the faculty member will discuss the issue with the student and determine if there is indeed a legitimate concern. The faculty member may determine that a grade of "F" is appropriate. Once a determination has been made the faculty member will submit a written report to the Dean of Academic Affairs.

### **Grade Appeals**

Students who want to pursue a grade appeal must do so within six (6) weeks of having been assigned the grade and must discuss the matter with the faculty member prior to officially filing an appeal. If the above criteria have been met and the student believes they have wrongfully been awarded a grade they may submit a written petition to the Dean of Academic Affairs. The petition must include an explanation for his/her rationale for believing the grade earned should be different. An official form can be secured from the Registrar's Office. After receiving the appeal, the Dean of Academic Affairs will discuss the concern with the faculty member. The faculty member will have five (5) business days to resolve the issue with the student. Ultimately, the decision for the grade is that of the faculty members.

However, if the grade concern is determined to be an alleged case of violating academic policy, harassment or some other consideration outside of the grading process, the matter will then be moved to the grievance procedure.

### **Student Grievances**

Filing a grievance or otherwise reporting harassment shall not cause any reflection on the individual's status as a student, nor shall it affect any future academic success of the student. The right to confidentiality, both to the complainant and of the accused, will be respected insofar as it does not interfere with PIHMA's legal obligation or ability to investigate allegations of misconduct when they are brought to its attention, or take corrective action when it is found that the misconduct has occurred.

If after direct discussion with the individual(s) the problem is not resolved to the satisfaction of the student, then the concerned student may meet with the Dean of Academic Affairs for resolution. A written response will be provided within five (5) business days. If the student is not satisfied with the response,

then the grievance along with the written response will be submitted to the Chief Academic Officer for final resolution. Final resolution of all grievances will be answered in writing within five (5) business days after the CAO receives the request. The final step in the College grievance procedure is the President. If not satisfied with the school's resolution of the grievance, the student may direct his or her grievance to the Arizona Department of Private Post-Secondary Education or the Accreditation Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine.
