### Fee Policy:

Refunds are for the semester. The American Medical College of Homeopathy at PIHMA reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Students are expected to pay in full all tuition and fees for the semester at the time of registration. No classes may be attended without registration for that class. All fees are non-refundable except as specified in the refund policy. Students who have not paid their tuition in full by the first day of class can be dropped from the class for the semester. Course credit will not be given until tuition and fees are paid in full. No transcripts or diplomas will be issued to students in default. In no case will students be permitted to register for a semester or take the final examination until all tuition and fees are paid in full for previous semesters.

### Payment Options:

Students are expected to make payment arrangements within 5-days of registration. Students can pay by cash, check, credit card or through financial aid (federal or private loans). Tuition and all fees must be paid in full by the end of the program. These options are available to all students

### Cancellation and Refund Policy:

Rejection: An applicant rejected by the Program is entitled to a refund of all monies paid.

Three-Day Cancellation: An applicant who provides written notice of cancellation within three days (excluding Saturday, Sunday and federal or state holidays) of signing an enrollment agreement is entitled to a refund of all monies paid. No later than 30 days of receiving the notice of cancellation, the school shall provide the 100% refund.

Other Cancellations: An applicant requesting cancellation more than three days after signing an enrollment agreement and making an initial payment, but prior to entering the school, is entitled to a refund of all monies paid *minus the tuition deposit fee of \$200.*

### Refund After the Commencement Of Classes:

1. Procedure for withdrawal/withdrawal date:
  - a. A student choosing to withdraw from the school after the commencement of classes is to provide written notice to the Director of the program. The notice is to indicate the expected last date of attendance and be signed and dated by the student.
  - b. For a student who is on authorized Leave of Absence, the withdraw date is the date the student was scheduled to return from the Leave and failed to do so.

- c. A student will be determined to be withdrawn from the institution if the student has not attended any class for 30 consecutive class days.
- d. All refunds will be issued within 30 days of the determination of the withdrawal date.

2. Tuition charges:

- a. Tuition charges will be determined based upon the percentage of the clock hours attempted. The percentage of the clock hours attempted is determined by dividing the total number of clock hours elapsed from the student’s start date to the student’s last day of attendance, by the total number of clock hours in the program (less the tuition deposit fee of \$200 if applicable)
- b. Tuition refunds will be issued within 30 days of the date of student notification, of date of school determination (withdrawn due to absences of other criteria as specified in the school catalog), or in the case of a student not returning from an authorized Leave of Absence (LOA), within 30 days of the date the student was scheduled to return from the LOA and did not return.

Tuition Refunds Are Determined as Follows:

- 1. Before the beginning of classes, the student is entitled to a refund of \$100% of the tuition (*less \$200 tuition deposit fee, if applicable*).
- 2. After the commencement of classes, the tuition refund amount, *minus the tuition deposit fee of \$200 (if applicable)*, shall be determined as follows:

% of the clock hours attempted:	Tuition Refund amount:
10% or less	At least a 90% refund
More than 10% and less than or equal to 20%	At least a 80% refund
More than 20% and less than or equal to 30%	At least a 70% refund
More than 30% and less than or equal to 40%	At least a 60% refund
More than 40% and less than or equal to 50%	At least a 50% refund
More than 50%	No Refund is required

- 3. **Books and Supplies:** There is no refund for equipment, books and supplies received by the student.

4. **Special Cases:** In case of prolonged illness or accident, death in the family, or other circumstances that make it impractical for the student to complete the program, the school may make a settlement which is reasonable and fair (optional language).

Holder in Due Course Statement:

Any holder of this consumer credit contract is subject to all claims and defenses which the debtor could assert against the seller of goods or services obtained pursuant hereto or with the proceeds, hereof Recovery hereunder by the debtor shall not exceed amounts paid by the debtor (A.R.S. §47-3302 - FTC Rule effective 5-14-76).
